- In person on Sunday 12 October 11am to 4pm. Bring your prefilled forms if possible.
- A link to a pre-filled membership form will be emailed out to current members who have not renewed in the first week of September and again in the first week of October. These links will only be valid for 30 days. This form should be checked, signed and either emailed, posted or brought with you in person on 12 October.

**Note 3** – **Minimum membership for Nippers** is 1 Nipper plus 1 parent/guardian. **New Nippers** must provide proof of age prior to membership being accepted.

**Note 4** - On 31 October, SLSCA will automatically archive every member who has not renewed. **Senior Members who renew after that date will be required to pay an additional \$50 administration fee.** This does not apply to Nipper categories or new members.

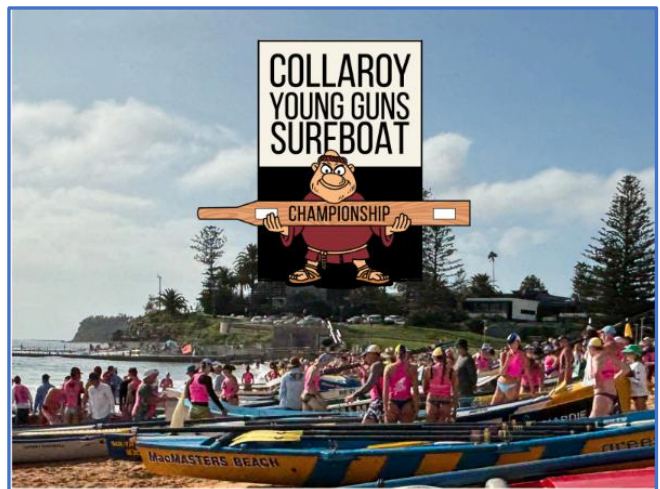

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## FROM THE HISTORY BOOKS.....

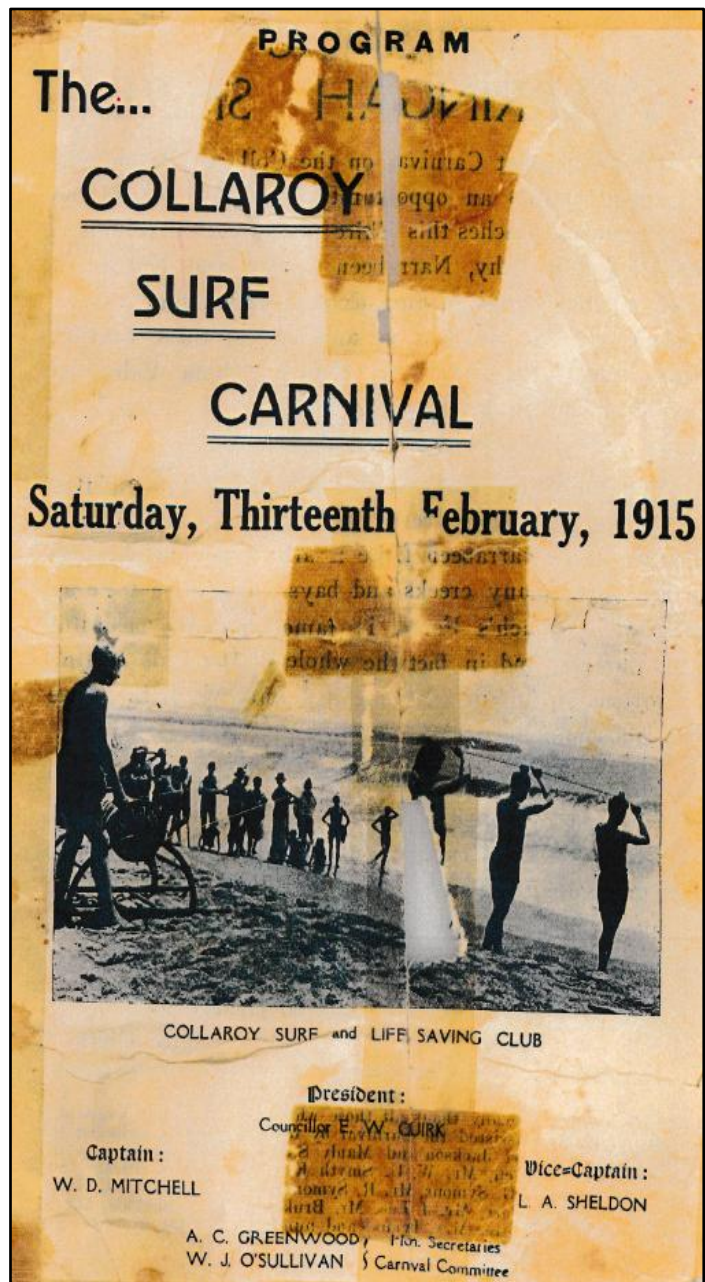
From our next carnival to our first carnival. Below is the programme from Collaroy's first 'official' carnival, held on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 1915.

In the early days, Surf Carnivals were designed to hone lifesavers skills in addition to provide entertainment with events such as the Fancy Dress Parade, Treacy Apple race, Carry a Chum Race, Obstacle Race, Pillow Fighting and Tug of War. They were held on Saturday afternoons or on Public Holidays as sporting activities were still illegal on Sundays.

Although the Club did hold an 'unofficial' carnival in early 1914, it had not yet affiliated with the Surf Bathers' Association (SBA). In October of 1914, the Club affiliated with the SBA and sought and was granted permission to hold it's first Carnival. A Carnival Committee and Refreshment Committee were formed and sponsorship was obtained from Warringah Shire Council and Port Jackson and Manly Steamship Company. Several private donations were also received.

A Carnival Program was printed and the cover contained a photograph of Collaroy members paying out line from a reel. This method of paying out the line over the head had only just been formalised. The program was used by the Council to sell the attractiveness of Collaroy and Warringah as well as by local businesses for advertising.

A 'Boys' race, a stretcher race, an obstacle race and an R&R display by the Newport Ladies Surf Club were features of the day. Club members who competed included Lionel Sheldon, Norm Casey, Bill Blakeman, Laurie and Hilton Borig, Austin, Bernie and Greg Dellit, Harry Ludowici, Jack Lette, Len



Chinchen, Bill Shepherd, Johnny Rankin, Bill Mitchell, John Hunter, Bon and Tiny Abbott and Frank Tindale. It was to be the last local carnivals for a few years.

One month after Collaroy's Carnival, the first Association Championships were held at Bondi and ten weeks later, Australian and New Zealand troops landed on the beach at Gallipoli.



## CHARMING WARRINGAH SHIRE

TO DAY'S great Carnival on the Collaroy Beach, will give visitors an opportunity of seeing one of the many beautiful beaches this Shire possesses. Freshwater, Curl Curl, Dee Why, Narrabeen Centre, and Narrabeen North, all have good surfing accommodation and a very pleasant day can be spent at any one of these centres. Other beaches in the Shire, namely, Mona Vale and Newport have similar facilities, and can be reached by taking tram to Narrabeen thence by motor.

The Shire has many other attractions, Broken Bay and Kuring-gai Chase being among the most popular. The Beautiful Narrabeen Lake is also a popular boating locality. Its many creeks and bays are always teeming with fish. French's Forest is famed for its beautiful native flowers, and in fact the whole of the hills behind the various surfing beaches are a picture when the native flora is booming.

Good accommodation and boats are obtainable at all the above resorts.

The progress of the Shire has been remarkable. In 1907 the assessments numbered 7,000 and in 1914, 13,600.
