## 2. EVENT ENTRIES & HOLDING OF EVENTS

- a. Surf lifesaving Sydney Northern Beaches will manage all entries.
- b. Entries will be possible via Live Heats, entries will be accepted until 21/01/2026.
- c. No late individual entries will be accepted.

## 3. ENTRY FEES

Surf Boats	\$125 per crew
R&R / Lifesaving Events	\$33 per Open competitor \$24 per Junior competitor
March Past Teams	\$120 per team

**Note: For surf boat entries and other events spanning both days Weekend @ 'The Roy' is considered one carnival**

## 4. RUNNING OF EVENTS (General)

- a. Once marshalling for an event has closed, late arriving competitors will not be accepted.
- b. The event organiser reserves the right to add or delete or change any events on the day of competition if safety, weather conditions, programming or other conditions warrant doing so.
- c. Results will be managed on Live Heats
- d. All protests shall be lodged with the appropriate Liaison Officer in each Area in accordance with the procedures set down in the current edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent bulletins and shall identify the specific sections/clauses in the Competition Manual and or event rules upon which the protest is based.

## 5. RUNNING OF EVENTS (Surf Boats)

- a. Round Robin and elimination round draws will be completed on Live Heats
- b. Round Robin countbacks will be based on:
  - i. Highest number of 1<sup>st</sup> Placings
  - ii. Highest number of 2<sup>nd</sup> Placings



- iii. Highest number of 3<sup>rd</sup> Placings
- iv. Best results where count back crews have competed in the same race
- c. Alley selection for a final will be selected by crews based on rankings at the conclusion of the round robin points score.

## **6. RUNNING OF EVENTS (R&R)**

- a. As per Competition Manual. Changes are at the discretion of the Sectional Referee.

## **7. RUNNING OF EVENTS (March Past)**

- a. As per Competition Manual. Changes are at the discretion of the Sectional Referee.

## **8. TENTS**

Club Tents can be bumped in on Friday 23 January from 4:00pm, please see [Event Maps](#).

No Club Tents are to be erected in front of the Surf Club Building or the beach access ramps.

## **9. CODE OF CONDUCT**

All members involved in competition are expected to co-operate to ensure a positive public image and to participate in a spirit of goodwill and sportsmanship.

Any incidents or behaviour likely to cause embarrassment or damage to the reputation and/or image of surf sports competition will be managed as described in the current edition of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual and any subsequent Bulletins.

## **10. POWER CRAFT AND WATER SAFETY**

Power craft and water safety will be provided by the Host Club.

## **11. FIRST AID**

- a. First Aid will be provided during the event and will be operational from 7:00am each day of competition. The Central First Aid Centre will be located within the Surf Club First Aid Room.
- b. There will be roving First Aid teams between water areas and beach areas.



- c. If a competitor is unable to walk to a First Aid location because of an injury, please advise an official who will contact a First Aid member to attend.
- d. If an Ambulance is required to attend the event for an injury sustained, this will be arranged through the SEMC/Host Club first aid team.

## 12. EVENT PARKING

There will be limited, paid parking at Collaroy Beach.

## 13. TRAILER PARKING

Access to the [trailer parking area](#) will be from 12pm Friday 23 January 2026. On competition days, access must be before 8:00am and exit only after completion of competition.

All trailers to be removed from the trailer parking area at the conclusion of the event.

## 14. MEDAL PRESENTATION

### R&R, Belt Race

- a. Medals presented at the completion of daily events, within the competition area.
- b. Medals not collected, medals will not be sent to home, Club or Branch addresses after the conclusion of the Championships.

### Boats & Marchpast

- c. Medals presented at the completion of daily events, upstairs within Collaroy Surf Club
- d. Medals not collected, medals will not be sent to home, Club or Branch addresses after the conclusion of the Championships.

## 15. SECURITY

There will be security onsite, overnight for the duration of the carnival. Although security is present, any valuables should not be left in Club tents or in the vicinity of the Club house.

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

### a. Master Plan






b. Lifesaving Competition Area






c. Surf Boat Competition Area
